Why the consumer prefer this



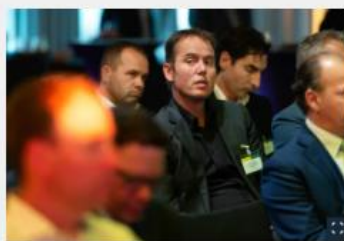
